



# 5 Fast Wins for New CISOs: A Tactical Checklist to Build Credibility Fast

When you're a new CISO, early traction matters. You're inheriting a complex environment, managing executive expectations, and working against the clock. These five wins are designed to help you quickly establish control, reduce real risk, and prove value in business terms.

## 1. VALIDATE AND PRIORITIZE YOUR ASSET INVENTORY

### WHY IT MATTERS:

*Visibility gaps = risk blind spots. Before you can defend, you need to know what you're protecting.*

### ACTIONS:

- Audit your asset inventory—assume your CMDB is ~60% accurate at best.
- Identify unmanaged devices, legacy infrastructure, and cloud workloads.
- Prioritize assets by business impact (customer-facing apps, finance systems, regulated data).

**QUICK WIN METRIC:** % increase in verified crown-jewel asset coverage

## 2. EXPAND AND MAP TELEMETRY COVERAGE

### WHY IT MATTERS:

*You can't detect or respond to what you can't see.*

### ACTIONS:

- Validate log sources across identity, cloud, endpoint, and network.
- Map telemetry coverage to your SIEM or MDR platform—where are the gaps?
- Run a simulated lateral movement or identity-based attack—can you trace the full path?

**QUICK WIN METRIC:** # of new log sources onboarded + % telemetry coverage on high-risk assets

## 3. REDUCE ALERT FATIGUE AND FOCUS ON WHAT MATTERS

### WHY IT MATTERS:

*Inherited noise clogs workflows, wastes analyst time, and hides real threats.*

### ACTIONS:

- Identify the top 10 noisiest detection rules—tune or suppress as needed.
- Apply business context to alerting: crown-jewel systems get elevated, low-value assets get deprioritized.
- Launch a suppression sprint with SOC or MDR partners to eliminate false positives.

**QUICK WIN METRIC:** % reduction in low-fidelity alerts + ratio of actionable to total alerts

## 4. FIX OR CONTAIN CRITICAL VULNERABILITIES

### WHY IT MATTERS:

*Demonstrating a measurable reduction in exploitable risk builds immediate trust.*

### ACTIONS:

- Prioritize patching for actively exploited or high-impact CVEs (especially on internet-facing assets).
- Where patching isn't possible, apply compensating controls: isolation, stricter logging, firewall tuning.
- Use threat intelligence to prioritize by exploitability, not just CVSS scores.

**QUICK WIN METRIC:** # of critical vulnerabilities remediated or mitigated within 30 days

## 5. DELIVER A 30-DAY EXECUTIVE SCORECARD

### WHY IT MATTERS:

*CISOs don't just fix things—they frame security as a business enabler.*

### ACTIONS:

- Package before/after metrics into a clean, visual report for execs.
- Align outcomes to business priorities: reduced downtime risk, faster incident response, improved audit posture.
- Include a roadmap preview—what you've learned, where you're going, and what support you'll need.

**QUICK WIN METRIC:** On-time delivery of scorecard + executive feedback or sponsorship earned

## FINAL NOTE:
