## **CHALLENGE**

For years, the company's IT and security teams managed cybersecurity internally, supported by third-party tools. But as the business grew across dozens of sites, the risk surface expanded dramatically. Ransomware attacks against manufacturing companies were rising, and insurers were tightening requirements for coverage.

"Our team was stretched thin, and we knew we didn't have the resources to monitor threats around the clock," recalled the Technology Services Manager. "We simply didn't have the budget or the headcount to stand up a 24×7 security operations center on our own. To cover all shifts, we would have needed to hire 8 to 10 people, each costing around \$150,000 annually. That just wasn't feasible."

At the same time, leadership was concerned about rising cyber insurance premiums. Without demonstrable improvements in detection and response, coverage was becoming more expensive—and harder to secure. The company needed a trusted partner who could reduce risk, provide measurable outcomes, and extend the capabilities of its in-house team.
